Floatation devices are allowed ONLY with prior permission from the guards and only with an adult in the water within arms reach of the child using the device. On crowded days, no floatation devices will be allowed. Noodles may be checked out from the guards and are allowed at the guard's discretion. Floatation devices pose a serious safety risk. They can tempt children and parents to feel a false sense of security. Children can slip out of rings and lifejackets and lose hold of noodles. If your child is using a device, you must remain within arms reach to prevent an accidental drowning. Thank you for your cooperation.
